Sports Enhancement Day

EYFS children from all schools will be taking part in some PE activities at Terrington Primary School. This event is held during school time and the children will be returned to their school before the end of the school day. Children in years 1 – 6 are asked to bring a packed lunch or order one from school. Please can orders be placed for a school packed lunch by **Monday 23rd February**, this is so our school cook can order items in. Choices of sandwiches are Ham, Cheese or Tuna Mayo. Children to come to school in their PE kits and bring a suitable jacket/coat for the weather that day. These will be sent home on the Thursday. Reception and nursery children will also take part in some different sports. If your child comes to school on a Friday and does not have their PE kit in school, please can they come into school in their PE kits. Hot school lunches will be available for reception and nursery children if they require one, these can be ordered on the day.



As part of our enhancement day the children be taking part in fundraising event for their school, this will involve the children participating in different types of circuit training.

The children in years 1 -6 will be completing this with an athlete of world class standard. This means they will have competed for the UK or Ireland at major sporting championships which include the Olympics, Commonwealth Games, World or European Championships, Paralympics or Invictus Games. The name of your athlete will be confirmed approximately 2-3 weeks before the event.

The reception and nursery children will be taking part in their circuits at Terrington school.
