Children's School Books – **POSSIBLE ACTION REQUIRED**

In line with updated GDPR retention guidance, we are planning to send pupils' exercise books and learning journals home at the end of the school year for families to keep and celebrate their child's achievements.

As part of children's learning, books may occasionally contain photographs of other pupils taking part in shared activities or collaborative work. Similarly, your child's photograph may appear in another child's book.

Removing every photograph from every book would be an extremely time-consuming process and, in many cases, would damage or significantly reduce the value of the children's work and learning records.

If you have any concerns or objections to your child's photograph appearing in another child's school book that will be sent home, please let the school office know by **Friday 3rd July**. This will enable us to consider any concerns before books are distributed.

If we do not hear from you by this date, we will assume you are happy for books to be sent home as planned.

Sports day Reminder

Parents and families are invited to join us from 12.15pm and may take their children home with them when sports day has finished roughly around 1.45pm. Buses will still be provided for those children who need them and will return to school before the end of the school day. Afterschool clubs will take place as usual. Please can you let your school office know if you are taking your children home after sports day.

All children should come to school in their PE kit, which is a white t-shirt, black shorts or jogging bottoms and trainers. Children should also wear their school jumper/cardigan and bring their own, clearly named water bottle. Please can we also ask that pupils bring a sun hat and sun cream is applied before school (a labelled bottle can also be brought with them). Please also send a coat/jacket with your child.
