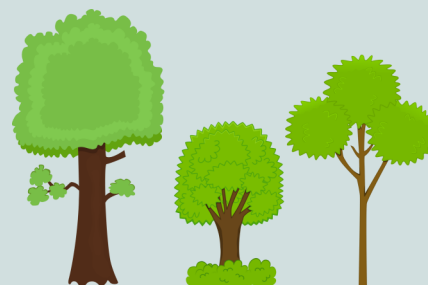

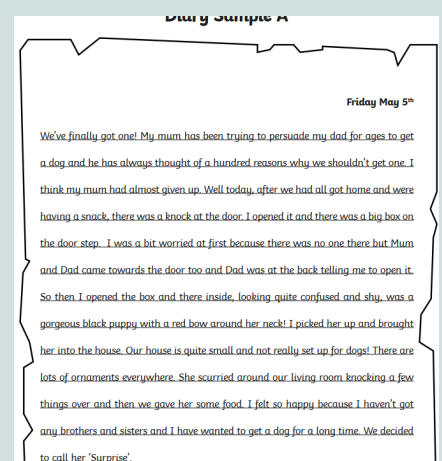


KS2 (CLASS2)
