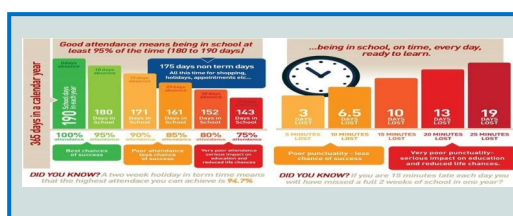
Special Catering Event!
