Christingle Service

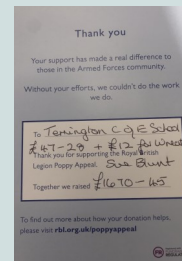
On Thursday 30th November all the children will be going to Terrington Hall for the Christingle service in the afternoon.

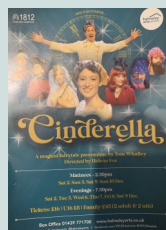
Forest School

A Magical fairytale pantomime.

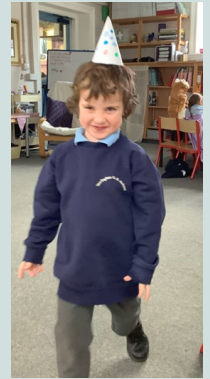


WOW WORK
