## Miss Skilling EYFS AND NURSERY

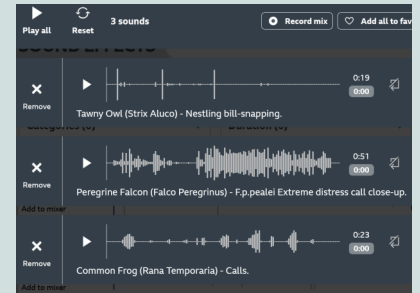
This week in Early Years we enjoyed going on our spring walk with KS1. We were looking for the first signs of spring and used our checklist to tick off when we could see any signs.

Stillington, Foston and Langton children will be travelling on buses to Terrington with adults from their school. This event is held during the school day, the children will be returned to their school before the end of the school day.
