## Uniform update:

## Key Updates and reminders:

**Footwear:** Students are required to wear **black shoes** as part of the school uniform. Please ensure your child has the correct footwear and children **should not wear trainers or open-toed sandals**.

**Bags:** To ensure all students' belongings, fit safely on their pegs, we ask that pupils use a school book bag, which can be purchased via: <https://www.schooltrends.co.uk/> and a draw string bag used for the PE kits.

**Water Bottles:** Students should bring a **water bottle of no more than 700ml** to stay hydrated throughout the day. Please ensure the bottle is clearly labelled with your child's name.

**Jewellery:** Fashion items are best kept for home, and for reasons such as health, safety and inclusion, fashion accessories such as make-up, nail polish, jewellery other than stud earrings and watches (no smart watches), should not be worn.

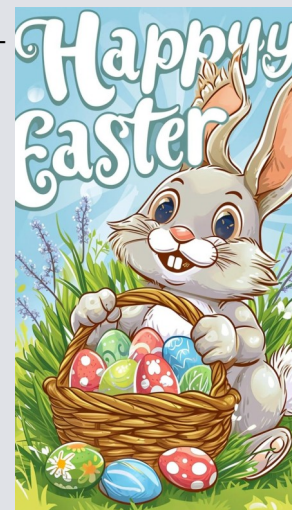
School do have spare uniform which is packaged for different age groups, please contact the school office if you wish to collect a pack.

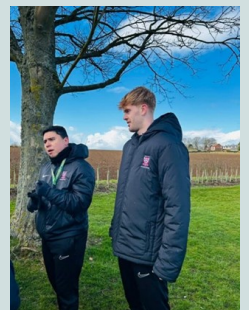
Well done Class 3 and I hope you all have a very well-deserved and enjoyable Easter break!

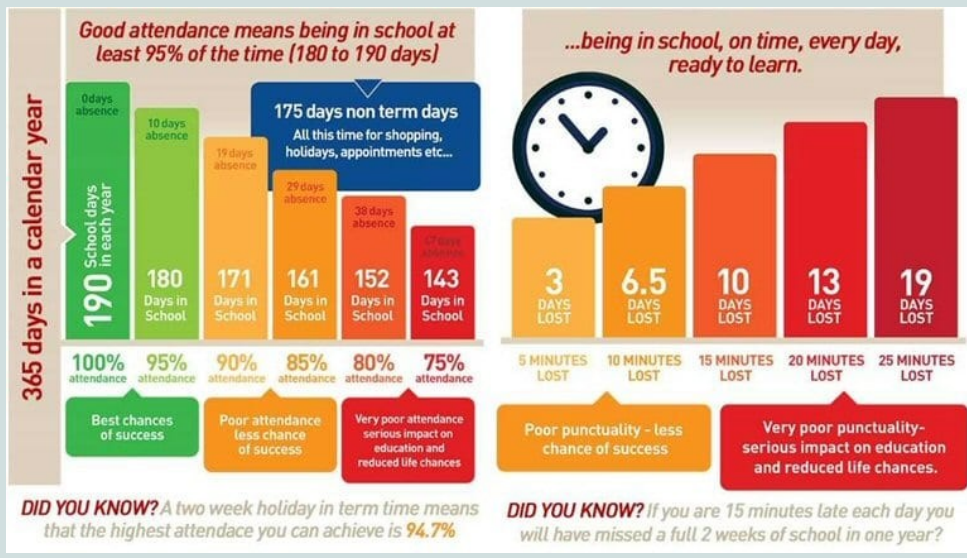
