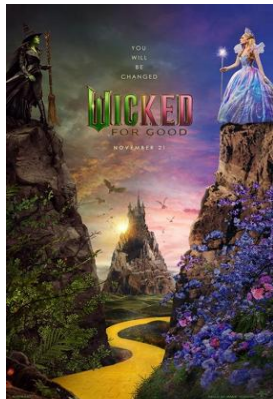
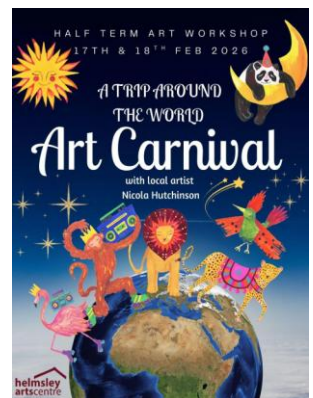
Art Carnival - A Trip Around The World Workshops
